

Regional Grant Program

In 2023, continuing the effort to support the ongoing recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic, the Foundation accepted applications for general operating or program support from organizations providing basic needs to their communities including, but not limited to, providing food, shelter, and meal delivery services.

The Foundation also accepted applications for general operating or program support from organizations addressing the extended social isolation experienced during the pandemic. Examples include, but are not limited to, arts and environmental organizations providing respite through connections to art and nature.

In an attempt to focus on smaller organizations, nonprofit organizations (or autonomous fundraising programs) must have a budget under \$5 million in order to be considered for funding.

Under these guidelines, The Beim Foundation awarded 35 grants totaling \$309,500 in 8 communities throughout the United States.
